CALIFORNIA DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION (DWC) OFFICIAL MEDICAL FEE SCHEDULE (OMFS) FOR PHARMACEUTICALS

Major Update to California's OMFS for Pharmaceuticals – Effective July 1, 2025

ComplQ, your trusted expert in workers' compensation billing, is providing guidance on a significant update to the California Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) Official Medical Fee Schedule (OMFS) for pharmaceuticals –the first major change since 2007. Starting July 1, reimbursement rates will be based on two new, state-published data files: the Pharmaceutical Fee Data and the NPI Pharmacy Dispensing Fee Data, both updated weekly.

To prepare, make sure your systems can capture NPI numbers for all pharmacy providers, which are now essential for calculating dispensing fees. The DAW (Dispense As Written) field must also be accurately completed when applicable. We will continue to keep you informed of any changes that may arise, so you can feel secure and confident in this ever-changing landscape.
